



First Presbyterian Church of Magnolia, Arkansas The Minutes for the Stated Meeting of the Session Tuesday, May 23, 2023, 6:00 p.m.

The Session of the First Presbyterian Church of Magnolia, Arkansas met for its monthly stated meeting on Tuesday, May 23, 2023. The following members were present, Moderator Dr. Pierre Boumtje, Elder Jodie Arnold, Elder Mary Bounds, Elder Dr. Dan Dykema, Elder Kathy Gean, Elder Ashley Hagaman, Elder Mike McNeil, Elder Anita Moore, and Elder Blake Pierce. Elders Debbie Arnold and Ryan Phillips had excused absences. Also present were Paula Boaz (Clerk) and Youth Director Katherine Phillips.

Call to order: Moderator Pierre Boumtje called the meeting to order, declared a quorum present, and opened the meeting with prayer at 6:00pm.

Youth and Family Ministries: Katherine Phillips had requested to present her report first and then be allowed to leave. Katherine reported that May has been a very busy month with the Youth focusing on The Ten Commandments. The Youth helped organize clothing for the Cameroon Mission and picked up trash on Jackson Street. In addition to Vacation Bible School, there will be monthly activities during the summer including Putt-Putt Golf in Texarkana. Elder Jodie Arnold moved to approve the request, Elder Mary Bounds seconded, and Session approved accordingly.

Committee Reports:

Administrative—Elder Blake Pierce reported that he has hired a roofer to repair the leak over the sanctuary entry. He is also getting new quotes on new security cameras for the church.

Cameroon—Elder Kathy Gean reported that the Mission/Evangelism Committee voted to approve \$5,000 from the Mission fund to be given to the Cameroon committee for supplies. Mission also requested that \$5,000 be given to the Cameroon committee, \$2,000 from Cameroon Fund and \$3,000 from unexpected expenses, for a total of \$10,000 for the summer trip to Cameroon. Elder Jodie Arnold moved to approve these requests. Elder Mary Bounds seconded, and Session approved accordingly. The Boumtjes plan to leave June 2nd and return to Magnolia August 16th.

Discipleship—Elder Mary Bounds announced that there will be no Bible Study during the Summer break. The Ladies' Circle will not meet during the Summer. The Ladies' Circle gave \$150 to Martine Boumtje to purchase soap bars for the Cameroon Women.

Fellowship—Elder Anita Moore reported that her committee will be preparing snacks for VBS and for the Wednesday end-of-school fun night.

Mission/Evangelism—Elder Debbie Arnold reported that in addition to donating money for the Cameroon Committee, they also continue to provide a monthly meal for the Southern Christian Mission residents.

Worship—Elder Mike McNeill reported that pulpit supply is filled through June, and they have made arrangements for Sunday Communion while Pierre is out of the country.

New Business: The new business was addressed earlier with the requested funds coming from the Mission Committee and General Funds.

Old Business: Church Security: Captain Mike McWilliams said he would be happy to come to our church and give on-site security training sometime in the near future. Blake and Bubba Smith signed up to attend the May 22nd training.
