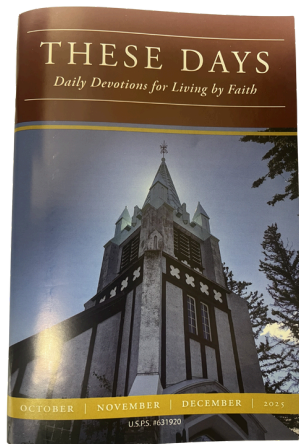


## Resources for You!
